Final Exam Guidelines

1. Pick up a copy of Student History form during ALL lunches (Dates to be Announced)
2. Present copy of Student History form to teacher for exam exemption verification

AP Exemption

All of these: Enrolled in AP course
Completed the College Board AP Exam for the subject
Spring semester course average of seventy (70) or above
No more than 3 absences for Spring semester*
No conduct grade lower than satisfactory
No discipline referral for the class of exemption (tardy referrals do not count)
No ISS/OSS/DAEP for the spring semester
Clear of all fines and detention hall requirements

Junior/Senior Exemption Gr. 11 & 12 All Classes

All of these: No conduct grade lower than satisfactory
No discipline referral for the class of exemption (tardy referrals do not count)
No ISS/OSS/DAEP for the spring semester
Clear of all fines and detention hall requirements

One of these: Semester grade of 90 or above w/ no more than 3 absences*
Semester grade of 80 or above w/ no more than 2 absences*
Semester grade of 75-79 or above w/ no more than 1 absence*

*Three (3) tardies in a specific class during the Spring semester count as one (1) absence for exemption purposes

Clear and compelling evidence of academic dishonesty results in student being ineligible for any exam exemption.

*All absences, except official school business, two (2) approved college visit days (Gr. 11 & 12 only), death in family, and religious holy days, will count (excused and unexcused).

Non-exempt seniors and juniors must attend every class for which an exemption is not earned.

Courses taught through computer-assisted or online instruction are not eligible for semester exams exemption.
