Nestled along the NASA Johnson Space Center in Houston and the boating waters of the Gulf of Mexico, Clear Creek ISD proudly serves the educational growth of more than 44,000 students and continues to be one of the most desirable places to raise a family in the Greater Houston area. Clear Creek ISD is the 29th largest school district in Texas, out of approximately 1,000 districts. Our district spans 103 square miles, 13 municipalities, and two counties (Harris and Galveston). CCISD students outperform their state-wide peers on all Texas standardized tests and college readiness indicators. Clear Creek ISD is comprised of 27 elementary, 10 intermediate, and 7 high schools. We pride ourselves on involving our stakeholders in making curriculum, finance, and policy decisions, and all of our decisions are made with the best interest of children in mind. **CLEAR BROOK HIGH SCHOOL** rests on the outskirts of Friendswood, a middle to upper-middle class suburban city located five miles from NASA's Johnson Space Center and three miles from Ellington Airfield. Major contributors to the local economy are the petrochemical industry, tourism, military, and the many businesses that serve a diverse suburban population.

CCISD CURRICULUM consists of over 300 courses for students to choose to prepare them for a variety of post-secondary opportunities. Courses are offered at both regular and advanced levels. Students may take 'Dual Credit' coursework on the campus of San Jacinto Community College South. Advanced Academic, Pre-Advanced Placement, and Advanced Placement courses are advanced levels that provide students with more concentrated study and receive weighted points on our G.P.A. scale. Classes are taught on a traditional 7 period day and numeric grades are awarded. A full description of our high school course offerings is available for download at: ccisd.net/myepg.

Due to the ongoing public health threat of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Clear Creek Independent School District created Clear Connections Online Learning Program. Clear Connections is a tuition-free K-12 online program of choice for the 2020-2021 school year. Clear Connections classes are taught by current CCISD teachers and mirror the quality of instruction occurring on the home campus. Clear Connections secondary students follow a daily seven period schedule that aligns with their home campus. Students' schedules require participation in real-time (synchronous) and independent (asynchronous) learning. Clear Connections Secondary Instructional Models include:

- **Pure Clear Connections:** daily interactions within an online collaborative setting led by a CCISD teacher and only with other Clear Connections students
- **Hybrid Clear Connections:** daily interactions within an online and Brick and Mortar collaborative setting led by a CCISD teacher and with other students in the course
- **Edgenuity:** a completely self-directed platform in which learning takes place any time and any place with a teacher available to assist with pacing and goal setting

High school course offerings for Clear Connections do include on level, Pre-AP and AP options, however, the course offerings are limited when compared to the course offerings at the Brick and Mortar home campus. High school students who participate in Clear Connections will have a "CC" course number on their schedule of courses and a "Z" indicator on their transcript during the 2020-2021 school year for all courses in which credit was granted through Clear Connections. Clear Connections students and Brick and Mortar students follow the same district grading guidelines.

Class Rank

Each semester course has a designated grade point level (GPA Level) used to determine rank in class and grade point average on a weighted 5.0 scale (EIC Local). Courses designated as Level 1 courses include Advanced Academic (Adv Acad), Pre-Advanced Placement (Pre-AP), Advanced Placement (AP), and Gifted and Talented (GT) courses. Level 2 courses include all general education courses. Level 3 courses are modified in content by the Special Education ARD committee.

Spring 2020 Semester Grades and Transcript Information

Due to the emergency closure of the Clear Creek Independent School District resulting from the imminent public health threat of the COVID-19 pandemic, CCISD transitioned from in-person instruction to distance learning from March 16, 2020 through the end of the 2019-2020 school year. As a result of the emergency closure, for the Spring of 2020, CCISD adopted a Pass/Fail grading system in which students were able to earn credit for courses taken and passed during the Spring semester; only "Pass" or "Fail" grades were recorded on academic achievement records and grade points were neither awarded nor included in GPA or class rank calculations. This grading system was adopted in order to maintain equity of the overall grading system and to accurately maintain semester grades on the transcript. Starting in August 2020, CCISD returned to the previously approved grading guidelines as established by district policy (see grading scale).
